During the week of October 9, 2017, the Lenovo Partner Network public websites (US and Canada) will be updated with a brand new look and feel along with new user experience enhancements.

The navigation and functionality of the new site should feel familiar to the old, but hopefully you will find the new navigation better organized, the enhancements useful, and the new site design refreshing.

Additionally, the site will now be encrypted (https) for better security. There will also be a slight update to all US LPN links, which will now include **/us/** in the URLs. The Canada URLs will remain the same.

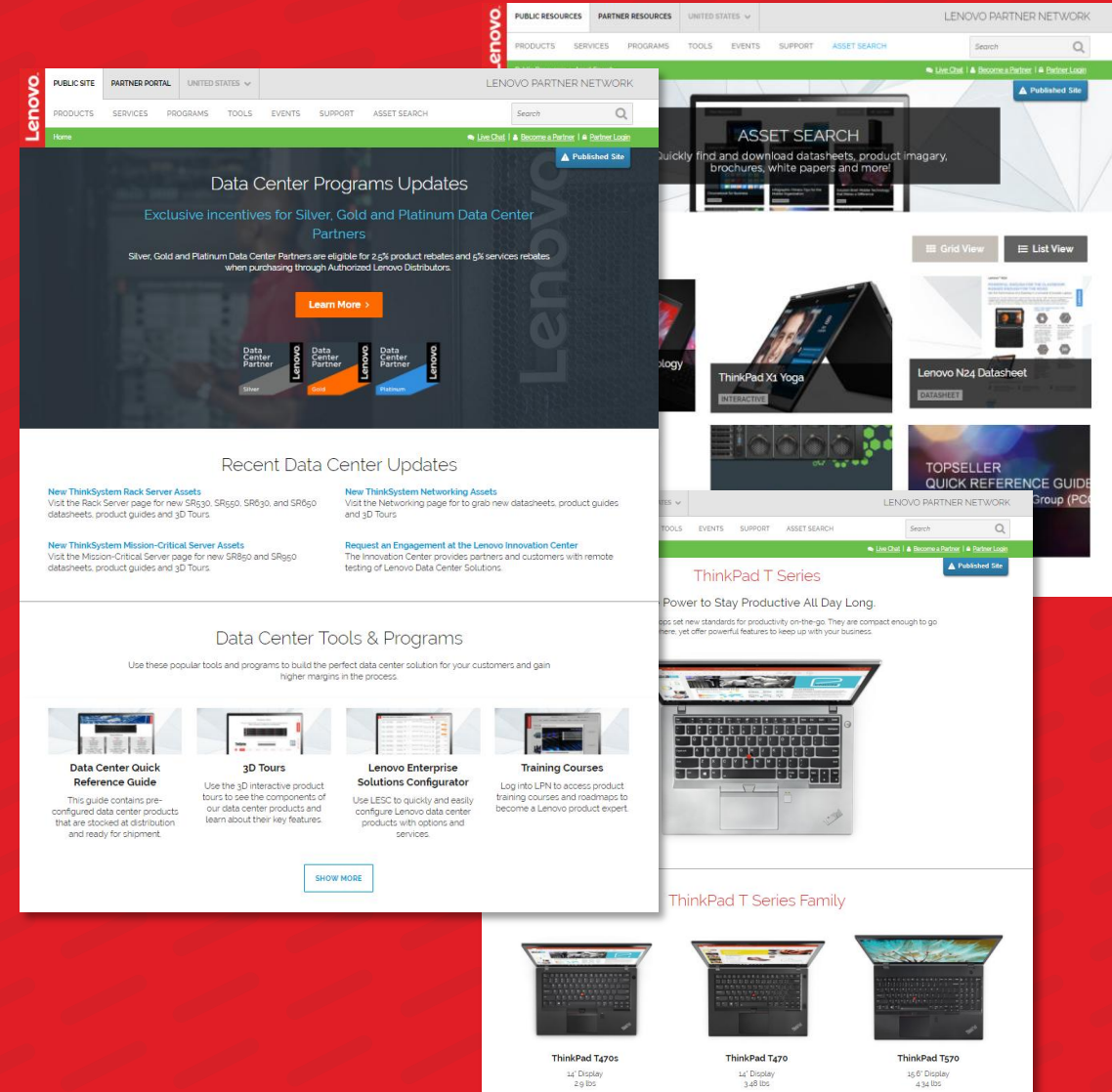

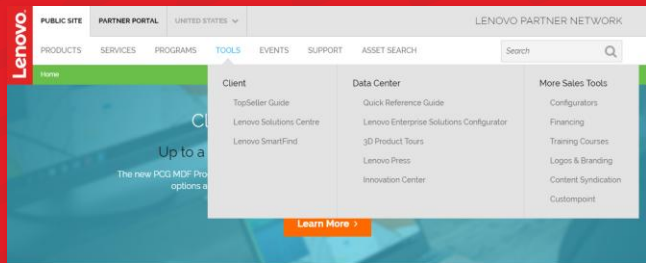
You should see no disruption in service when the new site is launched and there are redirects in place that will send you to the new site if you have old links bookmarked.

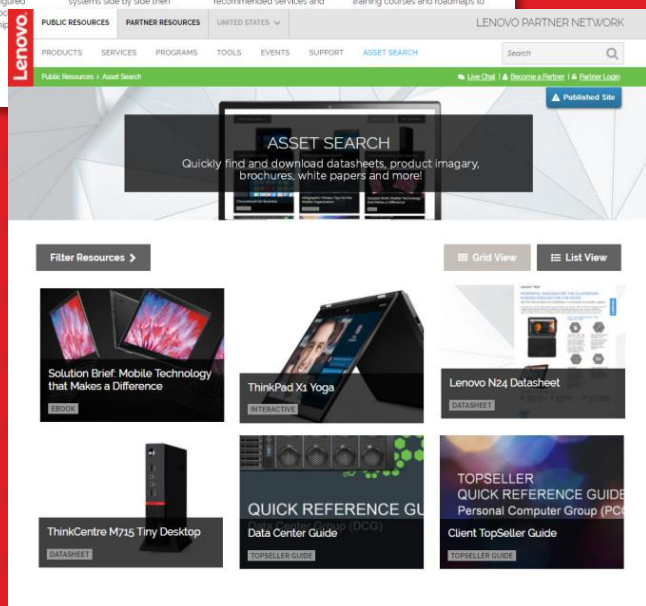
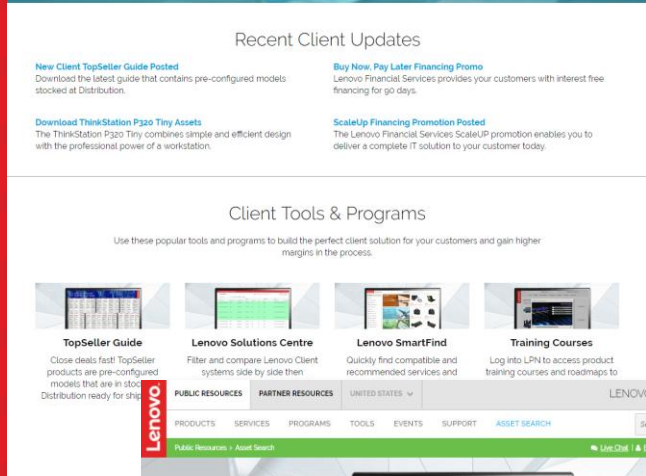
How you log into the Partner Portal (<https://my.lenovopartnernetwork.com>) and the look and feel of that site will remain the same at this time.

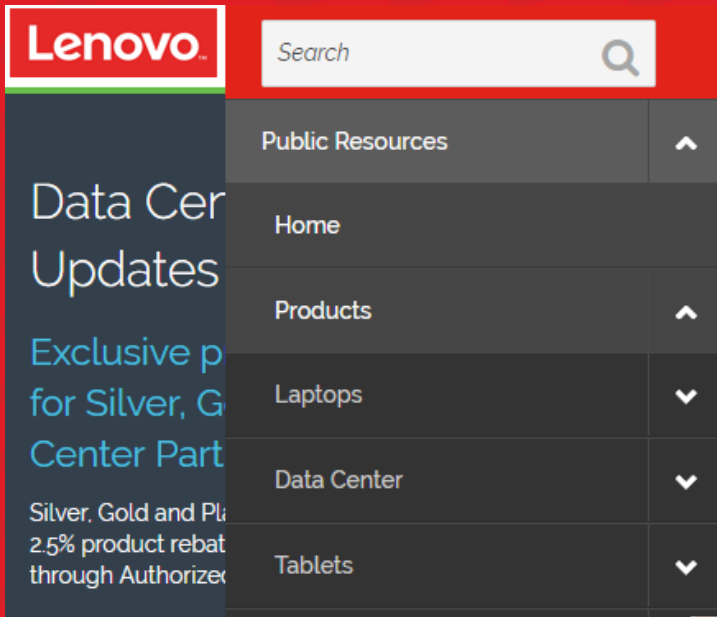

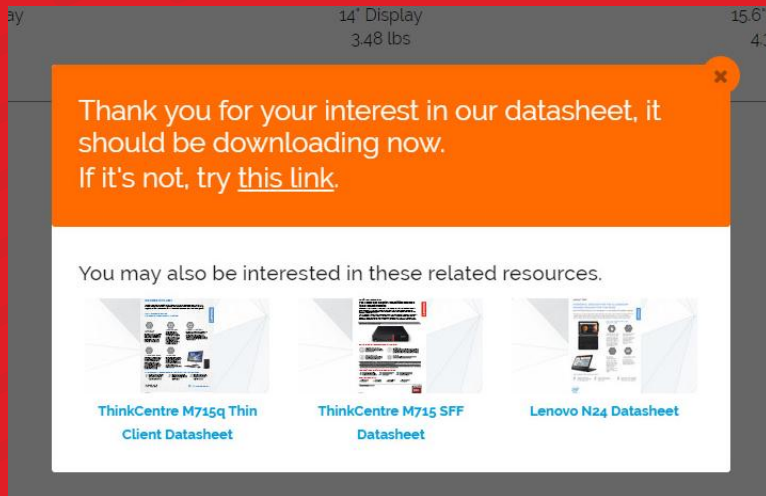
