

#### COMMVAULT ADVANTAGE FOR SERVICE PROVIDERS

## INFRASTRUCTURE as a SERVICE BACKUP (laaS BACKUP)

Infrastructure-as-a-Service Backup (IaaS Backup) is a Cloud-enabled Managed Service offered to tenants running workloads on the MSP's IaaS layer.

Tenants of the services can opt to provide Virtual Machine-level coverage for a subset or all of their systems under a Service Plan, with service options and extras allowing for further customization within the subscription.

- Agent-less, Hypervisor / Virtual Machine Image-level Protection
- Customize Service Plans with options to enable additional coverage
- Service reporting
- Customizable schedule, retention and storage options
- Data encryption options

#### BACKUP as a SERVICE (BaaS)

Backup as a Service provides protection to remote VM's, files and applications that a Service Provider does not host on-prem. It offers a level of self-service control via a web portal, thereby allowing the customer to interact directly with the service. Additionally the customer has the ability to choose the appropriate Service Offerings (including available features, options and extras) and Service Plans (which define schedules, number of data copies & locations, retention and recovery times) relevant to their business requirements.

These are just a few of the features and capabilities BaaS includes:

- Provide protection and recovery from accidental deletion or corruption of data
- Provide protection and recovery from a service failure
- · Provide application consistent data backup with granular recoverability for supported applications / databases
- Provide Reporting and Alerting visibility on Backup & Recovery Operations and Service Metering (Usage)

#### MIGRATION as a SERVICE (MaaS)

Migration as a Service is a Cloud-enabled Managed Service offering to tenants to assist in the onboarding of existing workloads into the service provider's Infrastructure as a Service offering. Tenants can opt to migrate a subset or all of their systems, with Service Options and Extras allowing for further accommodation of complex workloads and scenarios.
